4. COURSE DESCRIPTION AND TEACHING METHODOLOGY

The learning process proposed in the subject is dynamic, with constant interaction between teachers and students. Depending on the interests and maturity of the students, changes in the reading programme can be agreed upon, always respecting the general programme.

A combination of theoretical and practical aspects is proposed. The former will deal with the fundamental concepts and methodological aspects in order to know and understand European literatures and their importance in the development of Spanish literature.

In the latter, literary texts will be critically analysed, according to a combination of approaches (philology, literary criticism, reading close...). A gradual development of critical thinking is expected, in dialogue with the critical bibliography.

It is essential to read the compulsory literary texts, which will be discussed and debated in class.

If the infrastructure allows it, there will be 100% attendance. If the infrastructure does not allow 100% face-to-face teaching, there will be face-to-face teaching in alternate weeks. In the non-face-to-face weeks, teaching will be virtual for the whole group, and will be carried out synchronously and/or asynchronously. In the face-to-face weeks there will be sessions in which part of the students will attend class, while the rest will be able to follow these sessions synchronously by videoconference, as long as the technical means allow it, and other asynchronous sessions in which the students will have to carry out directed academic activities.

The attendance rotation system in the face-to-face weeks will be established according to the proportion between the number of students and the capacity of the assigned classroom.
